

AEMP Training at the CVMA Convention

This year's convention provided an opportunity for AEMP to further build veterinary capacity for responding to disasters. Loveland Fire and Rescue provided an awareness level training on Technical Emergency Animal Rescue to over 30 veterinarians and technicians. The session familiarized participants with rescue equipment and demonstrated a large animal lift.



Colorado Task Force 1, an Urban Search and Rescue Unit, provided over 25 veterinary professionals with decontamination basics for animals. This course included a practical exercise with dogs provided by Larimer Humane Society.



The Colorado Veterinary Medical Reserve Corps (CO VMRC) Introductory Training was fully completed by 22 participants during the convention. This course is required for membership in the COVMRC.
