Thank you for contacting Harrison Memorial Animal Hospital about your not-for-profit program's veterinary medical needs. Through generous donations from private individuals and service grants, we strive to fulfill our mission to promote responsible ownership and quality veterinary care for pets. - Spay/neuter services for all owners
- Veterinary medical services to pets of income-qualified owners

Although we are able to reduce the cost of care for our clients, our staff is still dedicated to providing full veterinary care to each patient we see. Our hospital is accredited by the American Animal Hospital Association (AAHA) at the highest level.

Full qualification levels will not only provide pet owners and animal help groups with discounts in our spay/neuter program, but also offer complete and caring preventive care, medical and surgical services. Fortunately, we can extend our donor-subsidized veterinary care to animal shelters, rescue groups, and other qualified animal-related services through our Community Partner Program.

To begin utilizing Harrison Memorial Animal Hospital, you must submit the attached application with the appropriate supporting documents. Use the checklist to help you provide all the necessary information. After receiving your application, we will contact you promptly regarding your status, and, if approved, set up an account in the name of your organization.

Services are provided on an appointment basis by calling our scheduling line. In cases of emergency, though it may not *always* be possible, we will make every reasonable attempt to accommodate the animal's needs.

If you will be sending a foster with the patient to an appointment, s/he will need authorization to allow treatment and/or diagnostics on the patient along with the associated costs. Unless other arrangements have been made with our accounting department, please provide payment at time of services.

We hope to work with you as a community partner and look forward to helping your animals. Please do not hesitate to contact me or stop by for a tour of our facility.
